## Room Identifier Program

In an effort to assist us in locating your child's room, we are providing you with the attached reflective marker. We are suggesting 2 possible options for placement depending on your home configuration:

OPTION 1 - Attach the reflective marker along the bottom edge of the door near the center and approximately 2 inches above the floor.

OPTION 2 - If the room does not have a door, place the reflective marker on the wall or door trim next to the opening and approximately 2 inches above the floor where it can be seen from either direction.

This is not a guarantee, but it will greatly increase the confidence that the fire fighter has that a child may be in that room.

If more than one child sleeps in the room, place the appropriate number of stickers along the bottom of the door spaced 1 inch apart.

Remember that this sticker is one piece of a "Home Safety Plan" that should consist of at a minimum:

- ✓ Working Smoke Alarms
- ✓ Carbon Monoxide Detector
- ✓ A Fire Escape Plan
- ✓ Regular Family Fire Drills
- ✓ Appropriate size and type of fire extinguisher

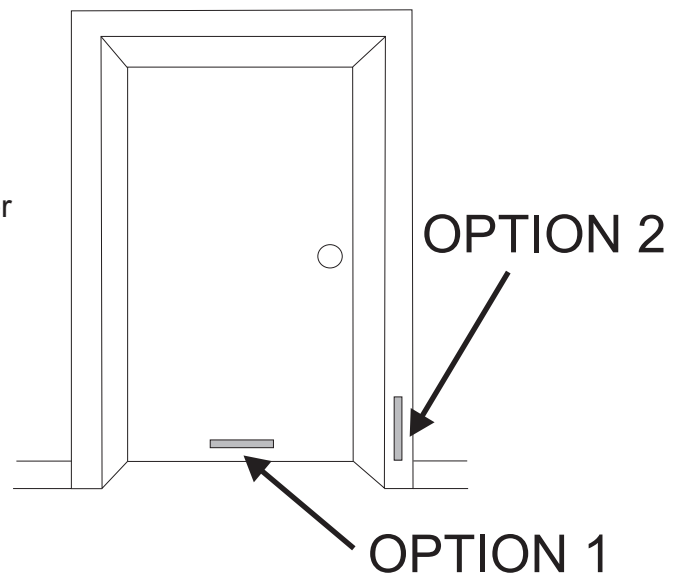
